

Carlow Summer Workshop Participants Information for June 25-28, 2019

Staying in the residence hall? Here's a list of what you'll need for your overnight stays:

- Twin sheets or a sleeping bag to cover the bed with

You will receive a t-shirt that you will wear when we tour off-campus sites, but you can bring clothes to change into after hours. For our trips off campus, please be sure to pack 1 pair of long pants, jeans or capri pants and a pair of closed-toe shoes that you are comfortable walking in.

Pick-up & Drop-off Location:

Program directors will be on site by 8:00 AM on Tuesday. Student drop-off will be at Carlow University Frances Warde Hall in Oakland. Please turn right off of Fifth Avenue at the Carlow driveway and park near the purple awning. That is Frances Warde Hall. Unload all personal belongings there. Registration will take place inside. We ask that students be picked up no later than 30 minutes after the posted closing time. Student pick-up will also be in front of Frances Warde Hall, where you were dropped off.

Parking Permits for Students with Cars:

If you are driving to the workshop, you will need a parking permit. Please contact Laurie Petty by email: ljpetty@carlow.edu and be prepared to provide the make, model, and license plate of your vehicle.

If you email us all of the information we need for your parking pass, we will have them ready for you. You should go ahead and park in Parking Lot A beyond the Carlow driveway, at the corner of Fifth Avenue and Craft Avenues and we will give you your parking pass to put on the dashboard of your car.

Additional Information:

Meals will be provided. You do *not* have to bring money, but there are vending machines available to you in the residence hall if you would like to purchase drinks or snacks. We will be going on the Gateway Clipper on Thursday evening and if you want money for snacks that is up to you. You also will have the opportunity to visit our bookstore on campus.
