

Carlow Summer Workshop Participants Information for June 27-30, 2017

Staying in the residence hall? Here's a list of what you'll need for your overnight stays:

- Twin sheets or a sleeping bag to cover the bed with

- You're more than welcome to bring any technology along with you (laptop, tablet, etc.). Free WiFi is available on campus.

You will receive a t-shirt that you will wear when we tour off-campus sites, but you can bring clothes to change into after hours. For our trips off campus, please be sure to pack a pair of closed-toe shoes that you are comfortable walking in.

Pick-up & Drop-off Location:

Program directors will be on site by 8:00 AM on Tuesday. Student drop-off will be in Carlow University Parking Lot A on Fifth Avenue (at the corner of Fifth Avenue and Craft Avenue) in Oakland. At the light, turn right to enter Parking Lot A. The AJ Palumbo Building (AJP) is right across the street. We ask that students be picked up no later than 30 minutes after the posted closing time. Student pick-up will also be in Parking Lot A, where you were dropped off.

Parking Permits for Students with Cars:

If you are driving to the workshop, you will need a parking permit. Please contact Laurie Petty by email: ljpetty@carlow.edu and be prepared to provide the make, model, and license plate of your vehicle.

If you email us all of the information we need for your parking pass, we will have them ready for you. You should go ahead and park in Parking Lot A as instructed above and we will give you your parking pass to put on the dashboard of your car.

All students: Once you park or are dropped off, you should cross Fifth Avenue at the light to enter the AJ Palumbo Building (AJP) where our workshop will be held.

Additional Information:

Meals will be provided. You do *not* have to bring money, but there are vending machines available to you in the residence hall if you would like to purchase drinks or snacks.

Transportation: During the program, we will travel to and from sites using Carlow University vans.
